

**Updated June 19, 2012 Version to Reflect October 1, 2012 Fee Start Date**

**BC LightRecycle Expansion – FINAL Member Presales and Contract Policy**

The “eco fee” would **not** apply to the supply or sale of any program products in the following scenarios:

- a. A legally-binding contract or proposal that can be verified through an audit has been awarded to and/or submitted by a program member at a set price prior to August 1, 2012 and the product is delivered and ownership has transferred to the recipient prior to October 1, 2013, provided the contract is not retendered on or after August 1, 2012.
- b. Payment becomes due or is paid without having become due to the program member prior to August 1, 2012 and the product is delivered and ownership has transferred to the recipient prior to October 1, 2013.

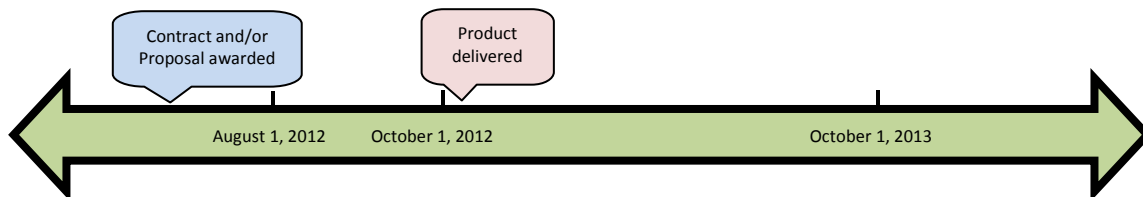
The “eco fee” would **apply** to the sale or supply of any program products in the following scenarios:

- a. A legally-binding contract or proposal that can be verified through an audit has been awarded to and/or submitted by a program member at a set price on or after August 1, 2012 and the product is delivered and ownership has transferred to the recipient on or after October 1, 2012.
- b. Payment becomes due or is paid without having become due to the program member on or after August 1, 2012 and the product is delivered and ownership has transferred to the recipient on or after October 1, 2012.
- c. Any program product that is delivered and ownership has transferred to the recipient on or after October 1, 2013, regardless of when a legally-binding contract or proposal was awarded to and/or submitted by a program member.
- d. Any program product that is delivered and ownership has transferred to the recipient on or after October 1, 2013, regardless of when payment becomes due or is paid without having become due to the program member.

**Examples where fees do not apply:**

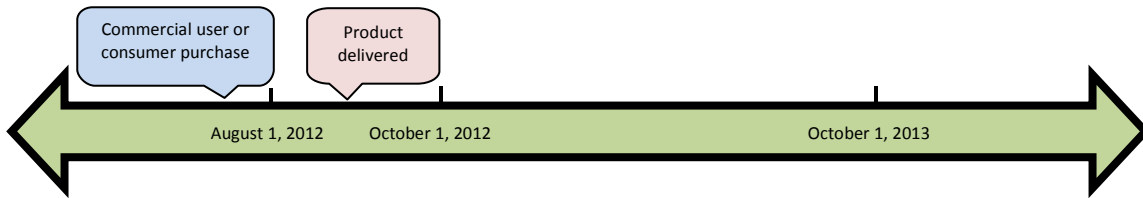
Example 1:

A legally-binding contract or proposal is awarded to and/or submitted by a program member at a set price for a program product on July 14, 2012 and the product is delivered on October 3, 2012. The eco fee does **not** apply to this sale.



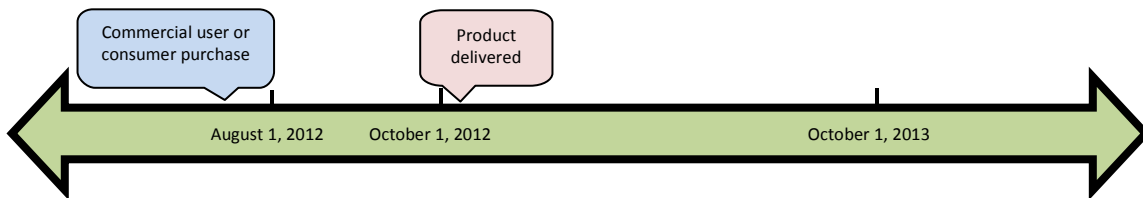
**Example 2:**

A consumer/commercial user purchases a program product on July 14, 2012 and the product is delivered on September 20, 2012. The eco fee does not apply to this sale.



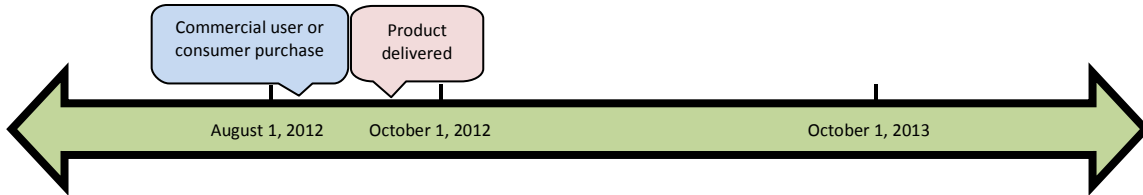
**Example 3:**

A consumer/commercial user purchases a program product on July 14, 2012 and the product is delivered on October 3, 2012. The eco fee does not apply to this sale.



**Example 4:**

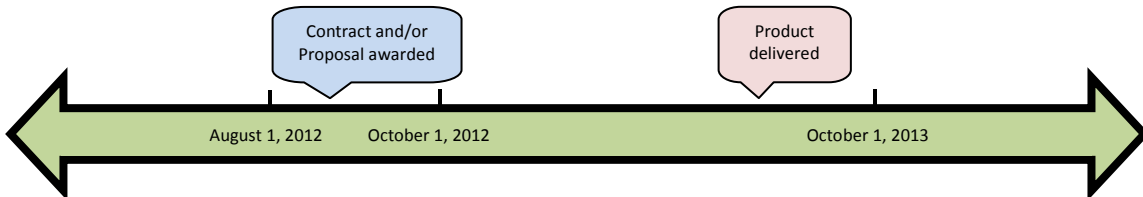
A consumer/commercial user purchases a program product on August 10, 2012 and the product is delivered on September 10, 2012. The eco fee does not apply to this sale.



**Examples where fees do apply:**

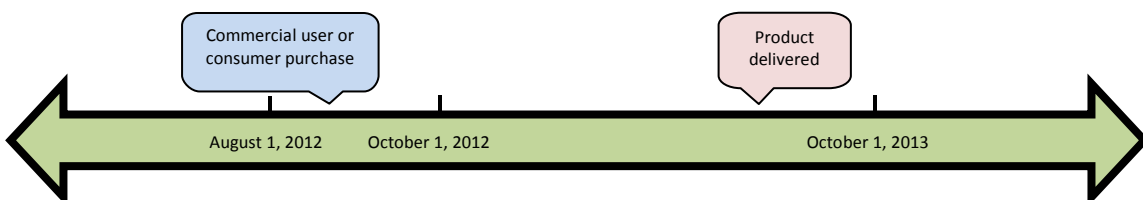
**Example 5:**

A legally-binding contract or proposal is awarded to and/or submitted by a program member at a set price for a program product on August 30, 2012 and the product is delivered on December 3, 2012. The eco fee does apply to this sale.



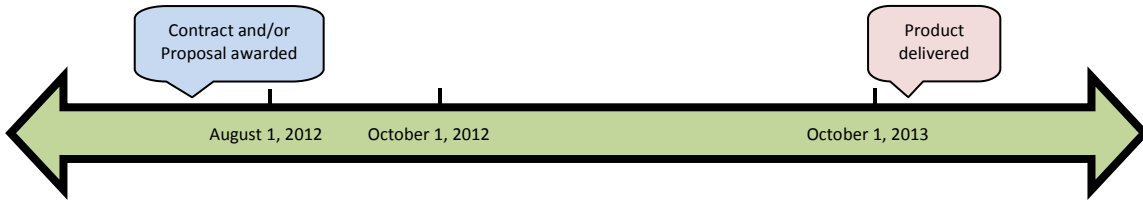
**Example 6:**

A consumer/commercial user purchases a program product on August 30, 2012 and the product is delivered on December 3, 2012. The eco fee does apply to this sale.



Example 9:

A legally-binding contract or proposal is awarded to and/or submitted by a program member at a set price for a program product on June 30, 2012 and the product is delivered on October 3, 2013. The eco fee does apply to this sale.



Example 10:

A consumer/commercial user purchases a program product on June 30, 2012 and the product is delivered on October 3, 2013. The eco fee does apply to this sale.
