



British Columbia Paint and HHW Environmental Handling Fees

The program is funded entirely by Environmental Handling Fees (EHF) remitted by ReGeneration's industry members. Environmental Handling Fees are paid by ReGeneration members based on their unit sales in the provinces where ReGeneration has programs.

The Environmental Handling Fee is taxable, as it is considered to be a part of the price of regulated products. While the taxes are remitted to the government, no part of the fee itself is remitted to the government.

Paint Products

- 100 ml – 250 ml: \$0.35
- 251 ml – 1 litre: \$0.65
- 1.01 – 5 litres: \$1.00
- 5.01 – 23 litres: \$2.25
- Aerosol paint (any size): \$0.35

Household Hazardous Waste Products

Flammable Liquids

- 750 ml or less: \$0.10
- 751 ml – 1 litre: \$0.15
- 1.01 – 2 litres: \$0.35
- 2.01 – 4 litres: \$0.60
- 4.01 – 10 litres: \$1.50

Aerosol Flammable Liquids

- 1 – 75 ml: \$0.01
- 76 – 200 ml: \$0.10
