As the year is quickly coming to a close we wanted to say thank you for being such an integral part of our program. The NS Paint program continues to be a great success thanks largely in part in the much needed and valued service you provide in your community.

In 2014, on the eve of its 20th anniversary of operation, Product Care was given a new name and a refreshed look. ReGeneration was born as the new face of Product Care. You can see the most immediate impact of the branding on our new website, ReGeneration.ca. Please know that from an operational standpoint, nothing changes, ReGeneration is simply our new consumer-facing name.

ReGeneration would like to remind depots that the following products are accepted under the program:

- all paint aerosols
- marine paints (except those which are registered as a pesticide)
- wood, masonry, driveway sealers or water repellants (not tar-based or bitumen based)
- deck coatings and floor paints (including elastomeric)

Our program only accepts architectural paint, which is to say, products that a consumer would typically buy and use around the house. Unfortunately, we are not currently able to put all the acceptable paint products on the brochure. Items that are not acceptable include items such as ice paint, tar-based coatings and roofing products, adhesives, non-aerosol automotive paint, tints and colorants, anti-fouling paint, industrial coatings as well as Unlabeled Containers.
