



British Columbia Lights Environmental Handling Fees

This program is funded entirely by Environmental Handling Fees (EHFs) remitted by Product Care's industry members. EHFs are paid by Product Care's members based on their unit sales in the provinces where Product Care has programs.

EHF's are taxable, as they are considered to be a part of the price of regulated products. While the taxes are remitted to the government, no part of the fee itself is remitted to the government.

Light bulbs	
Tubes measuring less than or equal to 2 feet	\$0.20
Tubes measuring greater than 2 feet and up to or equal to 4 feet	\$0.40
Tubes measuring greater than 4 feet	\$0.80
Compact fluorescent lights (CFL) / Screw-in induction lamps	\$0.15
Light emitting diodes (LED)	\$0.15
High intensity discharge (HID) and other: UV, Germicidal, UHP, Neon, etc.	\$1.10
Incandescent / Halogen	\$0.05
Miniature bulb package	\$0.10

Tubes include linear, U-shape and circ-line. Their length is the length of the tube if straightened.



Fixtures and Ballasts	
Designated small fixtures / Decorative light strings: flashlights, bike lights, night lights, Christmas light strings etc.	\$0.15
Fixture Category A: portable, small outdoor, decorative, light commercial, emergency, chandeliers, ceiling fans, linear fixtures, etc.	\$0.15
Fixture Category B: non-linear, commercial and industrial, etc.	\$0.15
Large outdoor fixtures: flood, sports, highway, street, etc.	\$0.15
Ballasts / Transformers (not integrated into lamps or fixtures)	\$0.15
