



Manitoba Paint and HHW Environmental Handling Fees

The Environmental Handling Fee is taxable, as it is considered to be a part of the price of regulated products. While the taxes are remitted to the government, no part of the fee itself is remitted to the government.

Paint Products

Flammable Liquids

- 100 ml or 250 ml : 0.20¢
- 251 ml – 1 L: 0.25¢
- 1.01 L – 5 L: 0.60¢
- 5.01 L – 23 L: \$1.50
- Aerosol paint (any size): 0.25¢

Household Hazardous Waste Products

Flammable Liquids

- 750 ml or less: 0.05¢
- 751 ml – 1 L: 0.10¢
- 1.01 L – 2 L: 0.20¢
- 2.01 L – 4 L: 0.40¢
- 4.01 L – 10 L: \$1.00

Flammable Aerosol

- 1 – 75 ml: 0.01¢
- 76 – 200 ml: 0.05¢
- 201 ml and over: 0.10¢

Pesticides

Last Updated: May 6, 2015

- Less than 10 ml or g: 0.01¢
 - 0.01 L – .89 L or kg: 0.60¢
 - 0.9 L – 1.79 L or kg: \$1.20
 - 1.8 L – 10 L or kg: \$2.40

Toxics

- 0.750 L or kg or less: 0.05¢
 - 0.751 – 1 L or kg: 0.10¢
 - 1.01 – 2 L or kg: 0.20¢
 - 2.01 – 4 L or kg: 0.40¢
 - 4.01 – 10 L or kg: 1.00¢

Toxic Aerosol

- 1 – 75 ml: 0.01¢
 - 76 – 200 ml: 0.05¢
 - 201 ml and over: 0.10¢

Corrosive

- 0.750 L or kg or less: 0.05¢
 - 0.751 – 1 L or kg: 0.10¢
 - 1.01 – 2 L or kg: 0.20¢
 - 2.01 – 4 L or kg: 0.40¢
 - 4.01 – 10 L or kg: 1.00¢

Corrosive Aerosol

- 1 – 75 ml: 0.01¢
 - 76 – 200 ml: 0.05¢
 - 201 ml and over: 0.10¢
