Re: PEI Paint Stewardship Program Amendment

Product Care Association of Canada (PCA) operates the PEI Paint Stewardship Program (the "Program"), pursuant to the Materials Stewardship and Recycling Regulations (the "Regulation") issued under the *Environmental Protection Act* of Prince Edward Island. PCA's paint stewardship program plan received approval from the Department on June 25, 2012.

Section 43 of the Regulation requires PCA as the operator of the Program to review the paint material stewardship program every five years after the date the program was first approved, and either submit proposed amendments or advise to the Minister in writing that no amendments are required.

In PCA's opinion, the PEI Paint Stewardship Program continues to perform effectively in diverting leftover paint from the environment. Accordingly, please accept this letter as Product Care's submission to the Minister pursuant to Section 43(b) of the Regulation, that no amendments to the PEI Paint Stewardship Program are necessary and therefore approval for the extension of the Program for another 5-year term is requested.
