About Product Care

Product Care Association (PCA) is a federally incorporated, not-for-profit organization that creates implements, and leads successful waste diversion programs across Canada and in the United States. PCA has been in the business of paint recycling programs since 1994 when the first extended producer responsibility regulation for paint in Canada was passed in British Columbia. For 30 years, we have been responsibly managing paint and have continued to expand our range of accepted materials on behalf of our stewards as new Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) regulations come into force.

Program Overview

On November 30, 2022, Alberta's Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) <u>Regulation (AR 194/2022)</u> was enacted. This regulation mandates that obligated producers establish systems for managing single-use products, packaging and paper products (PPP), and hazardous and special products (HSP) by April 1, 2025.

Product Care is assisting producers in complying with the Alberta Hazardous and Special Products (HSP) regulations. We have registered as a Producer Responsibility Organization (PRO) with the Alberta Recycling Management Authority (ARMA), holding the registration number 00014968. Our registration covers the following products: corrosives, flammable liquids/solvents, gasoline, non-refillable pressurized containers, pesticides & toxics.

Registration with Product Care as a PRO for Alberta HSP Products

The information provided outlines the steps to register with Product Care as a PRO for AB HSP Products. Producers must first register with ARMA for HSP before completing their final registration with Product Care. The deadline for producer registration with ARMA and with Product Care is March 1, 2024. Both, existing and new members of Product Care are required to register for AB HSP products through the Product Care member portal.

Timelines and Requirements

By March 1, 2024, obligated producers are required to:

- 1. Register with Alberta Recycling Management Authority (ARMA) for HSP.
- 2. Register with Product Care for the Alberta HSP Program.

How to Register with Alberta Recycling Management Authority (ARMA) as a Producer

Obligated producers are required to register with the Alberta Recycling Management Authority (ARMA) before they can register with Product Care. During the ARMA registration process, AB HSP Producers must select Product Care as their chosen Producer Responsibility Organization (PRO) for the Alberta HSP Program.


For New Product Care members

Creating an Account with Product Care


- If you are a new AB HSP producer, your first step is to create an account with Product Care.
- During the online registration process, it's important to click "Next" only once. Double-clicking may result in error messages.
- To begin this process, please visit: create a new account to access the account creation page.

Step 1: Contact Information


• On the "Contact Information" page, accurately fill in all the required details. Once you have entered and confirmed your information, click "Next".



Step 2. Complete and confirm the "Company information" and "Primary Address" details, then click "next".



Step 3. On the "Program Selection" screen, select all the product categories that you want to register for, then click "next".




Step 3b. "Supplementary Agreement to appoint Product Care as PRO for Alberta programs"

By clicking 'yes- I agree', you appoint PCA as your AB HSP PRO for the selected products.

Please add your ARMA Program Registration Number (obtained from your ARMA registration).


Answer the Type of Producer and Franchisor questions, click "next".



Step 4: Read and agree (not-agree) with the "PCA Membership Agreement", click "next".



Step 5. Complete registration. Click the 'Complete Registration' button.



Your registration request will be reviewed by PCA, usually within 2 business days.

For Existing Product Care members

Product Care members can register with Product Care for AB HSP products through the <u>member</u> reporting portal.

 During the online registration process, it's important to click "Next" only once. Double-clicking may result in error messages.

AB HSP Registration steps (for existing members)

Important: this step should only be completed once you have registered with ARMA and have an ARMA registration number.

Step 1. Log into the <u>member reporting portal</u> using your login credentials.


Step 2. Under the "My Account" drop-down menu, select "Programs" to add AB HSP to your membership agreement.



Step 3. On the "Edit Program" page, you can add various AB HSP product categories to your member agreement, click on the "next" button.






Step 5. "Modify Programs" – on your PCA Membership Agreement
