

PCB-Containing Lighting Ballasts Generator Declaration Form

Some lighting ballasts manufactured prior to July 1, 1980 contain polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) and require special handling. The LightRecycle program provides a pick-up service to generators with PCB-containing lighting ballasts generated in British Columbia without charge. To qualify for a pick-up service, generators must complete the following declaration form (both pages). Once completed, the form can be scanned and emailed to **BCdispatchlights@productcare.org** (preferred option) or faxed to **604 592-2982**.

Special considerations:

If the material is leaking and covered with black tar, do not send it to Product Care for collection. Instead, contact RCBC Information Services | Recycling Council of British Columbia (<https://rcbc.ca/information-services/>) or a qualified private contractor to determine the appropriate disposal method.

<i>Note: Polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) contained in lighting ballasts are classed as Waste Articles Containing Polychlorinated Biphenyls (class 9, UN2315, PGII) under the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations (TDGR). Generators that produce, store, or ship in a 30 day period, any volumes in excess of 5 kg are required under the BC Hazardous Waste Regulations (BCHWR) to register as a generator of hazardous waste in BC. Whereas:

- A. Product Care Association (PCA) has developed and operates the Light Recycling Program, a product stewardship program for Lamps and Lighting Equipment (including PCB-containing lighting ballasts) in British Columbia and has a product stewardship plan approved by the BC Ministry of Environment pursuant to the Recycling Regulation
- B. The Generator possesses PCB-containing lighting ballasts and wishes to utilize PCA's stewardship program for the transportation and disposal of these products.
- C. The following describes the terms and conditions of the service provided by PCA.

In consideration of the services provided by PCA to the Generator, and in recognition of the costs incurred by PCA in providing services, the Generator represents and agrees as follows:

- 1) The Generator acknowledges and agrees and certifies that for this shipment, the Generator:
 - a. Has properly identified and segregated PCB-containing lighting ballasts from other products and has ensured that no other products, such as lighting ballasts that do not contain PCBs, are placed in the collection containers for PCB-containing lighting ballasts.
 - b. Has Packaged the PCB-containing lighting ballasts in properly labelled, PCA approved collection containers in accordance with the guidelines provided by PCA to the Generator.
 - c. Will make the PCB-containing lighting ballasts available for pick up only by the PCA approved service provider dispatched by PCA for that purpose.
 - d. Has provided the Generator's BC Generator Registration Number, if applicable (see above).
 - e. Has ensured the PCB ballasts were generated within British Columbia.
- 2) PCA reserves and/or its agents reserve the right to inspect collection containers and refuse current or future pick-up service for non-conformance with the above conditions.
- 3) In the event that, in the reasonable determination of PCA or its agents, the collection container includes any product other than PCB-containing lighting ballasts as described in this document, the Generator agrees to pay to PCA upon demand the full transportation and disposal cost of the collection container plus an additional administrative charge of 25% of the disposal cost.
- 4) PCA reserves the right to discontinue service to the Generator in the event of default of this agreement.
